

Ninnekah Public School Foundation Internet Program

A benefit for Ninnekah Public Schools Faculty & Students

The Ninnekah Public School Foundation has reached an agreement with AT&T wireless to offer special, discounted wireless internet accounts to the faculty and students of Ninnekah Public Schools. The plan is \$55 a month with unlimited data. The plan is \$45 a month for users that subscribe to automatic payments. Automatic payments require a PayPal account. All new accounts receive a portable hotspot. There are no carrier contracts required and limited termination fees with these accounts.

To sign-up for the program, participants must complete an enrollment form and pay an initial \$55.

The Foundation can provide access to test hardware or a representative to answer questions with appropriate lead time. The monthly fee has been rounded-up for simplicity and to guarantee a stable price for several years. Any additional funds will be added to the Foundation general fund, which can be granted back to the school for teacher training, classroom programs and other benefits.



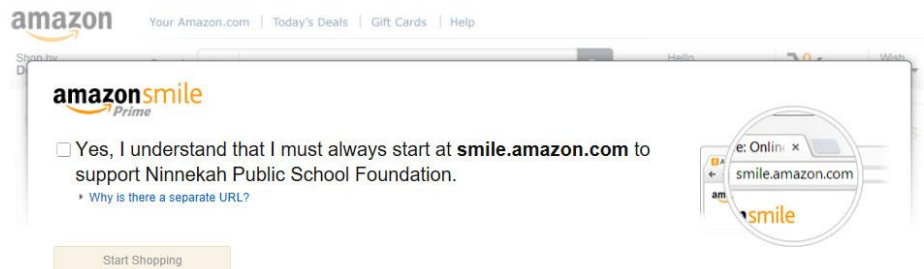

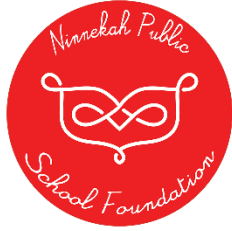
